Agency Resources

- <u>Managing Agency Users</u>: New section added for resetting a user's multi-factor authentication (MFA).
- Reviewing Information Request Responses: Added a note explaining how to export information request responses to Excel.
- Responding to a Report Response Due Date Extension Request: New resource available 4/10/22.
- <u>Viewing Complaints Reports</u>: Updated data point to indicate "Total Monetary Relief Provided to Complainant"
- <u>Managing Loan File Requests</u>: Added information about where multiple file sharing links are displayed, if more than one is used.

- <u>Using Discussion for Non-NMLS Entities</u>: Added a note about the "All Agencies" tag.
- <u>Sending a Complaint for Referral</u>: Updated language in the referral form to no longer reflect "active SES users" and updated outdated screenshots.

- Adding and Removing Information Requests: Added a new section "Exporting Information Requests."

- <u>Conducting the Exam for the EIC Findings</u>: Updated to include information about adding a repeated finding and exporting finding commentary.
- <u>Conducting the Exam for Participants Findings</u>: New resource available 4/10/22. Helps
 to differentiate the tasks available to participants vs. those available to the EIC regarding
 findings.
